Examples of what your donations provide

Blood pressure monitors, approximate cost £20: Monitoring blood pressure at home gives a better reflection of a person's blood pressure and can help to avoid the risk of stroke or heart attack.

Nebulisers, approximate cost £50: Used by people living with asthma or COPD to breathe in medication as a mist through a mask or mouth piece.

Doppler machine, approximate cost £400: an ultrasound device used to estimate blood flow through blood vessels and to diagnose conditions including blood clots, blocked arteries or reduced circulation.

ECG machine, approximate cost £1500: Can detect problems with the heart's rhythm and even help to indicate whether a patient has had or is having a heart attack.
